

## Brick Cleaning Accreditation Short Course CPC10111 – Certificate I in Construction

### **Are there any special equipment or qualifications that I need for the course?**

You will need to provide your National White Card (previously Green/White card) Work Safely in the Construction Industry [CPCCOHS1001A] at the beginning of the course on day 1 as this is a prerequisite for this course. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required:

- Safety glasses (Clear)
- Ear muffs or ear plugs
- Appropriate clothing
- Appropriate footwear for the practical tasks (no thongs or open toe shoes)

Applicants must have at least one of the following:

- Prior work experience in the Brick Cleaning Industry.
- Knowledge of the Construction industry and then able to gain work as a brick cleaner after the course.

A portfolio of evidence, showing the work you have performed, on at least two brick cleaning jobs must be provided within 12 months of completing the course.

The portfolio requirements include before and after photographs; diary entries; invoices; receipts and verbal references from at least two companies / builders.

The portfolio requirements will be further explained during the course.

### **Will there be an assessment for the course?**

Yes there is a work place assessment that will need to be done in order for you to get your Certificate I in Construction. This will be organised during the course with your teacher. You will need to make sure that you have a site that you can have your assessment done or it can be done onsite at Randwick College.

### **How much is the course?**

The course is \$1600.00 GST free (Course cost subject to class numbers). This cost is payable to TAFE NSW upon enrolment. This cost also includes your business on the accredited brick cleaning list on the Think Brick website.

### **How do I pay for my course?**

Payment is required when you enrol on the course through the Sydney website

**Course content:**

This course has been designed to reflect the packaging requirements for CPC10108 Certificate I in Construction within the Construction, Plumbing and Services Integrated Framework Training Package (CPC08). 11 units of competency are required for award of this qualification (8 compulsory units and 3 elective units).

A maximum of one of the three required elective units below may be substituted by selecting a relevant unit of competency from any Certificate I or II construction qualification or qualification in another endorsed Training Package.

CPCCPD3029A	Remove graffiti and apply protective coatings
