Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 noon Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 22/03/2019. Withdrawal of nominations must be in writing and addressed to the Returning Officer via any of the lodgement method(s) mentioned above.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 23/04/2019 and close at 10:00am Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 14/05/2019.

Scrutineers

According to rule 13.5, a candidate may appoint a scrutineering in writing to represent his interests in the conduct of the ballot.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
